

The Symphony Choir of Johannesburg, joined by the Pacific Boychoir from the USA, present a special Haydn Memorial Concert to celebrate 200 years since his death. Haydn's Paukenmesse is one of his last six symphonic masses. Soloists are Hanli Stapela (soprano), Veramarie Meyer (alto), Nicholas Nicholaidis (tenor) and Jaco Klopper (bass).

The programme includes two unusual motets for choir and orchestra, one by Joseph Haydn and the other by his brother Michael.

And to celebrate Mendelssohn's 200th birthday, Francois du Toit will perform his 2nd Piano Concerto in D Minor.

All of this with the Johannesburg Festival Orchestra conducted by Richard Cock.
